Performance Suggestion

I think the beginning through bar 28 work well when sung by soloists or triple quartets from each sections (if your choir is large enough). When doing this have the rest of the singers play the body percussion part in bars 20 through 33 while the soloist (or triple quartet) focus on singing. Bars 33 to the end are tutti.

I hope you and your choir cut loose and have a lot of fun with this song.

Body Percussion



*pat the outside of your left thigh with your right hand while simultaneously patting your chest with your left hand.

Remember to keep the patting and clapping light. It should not hurt.




































San Fransco, CA. - Winter 2014
