**"These Walls Must Fall"** - The title is from the Suffragette rally song, "*The Women's Party Song*."

**"We have many things to say."** - This paraphrases Susan B. Anthony's statement to the court at the end of her trial for voting in the 1872 election:

Judge Hunt asked "*Has the prisoner anything to say why sentence shall not be pronounced?*"

Susan B. Anthony replied: "*Yes, your honor, I have many things to say*"

**"Truth is the only ground to stand on"** - Elizabeth Cady Stanton quote

**"the rights we deserve"** - Alice Paul quote

**"No justice, no peace / This is what Democracy looks like."** - This section's text is made up mostly of chants heard in 2020 rallies, marches that were descendants of the protests and civil disobedience of the Suffragettes.

**"Alice Paul - Hope is waking / Elizabeth Cady Stanton - Dawn is breaking..."** - This call & response section includes the names of iconic Suffragette leaders, as well as lyrics adapted from the Suffragette rally song "*The March Of The Women*."
