## Transcriber's Note

Rimsky-Korsakov's popular march from his 1889 opera-ballet "Mlada" has been a favorite of symphony and concert band audiences. Now it can be presented in this transcription for Organ, Brass, and one or two percussionists. It is long overdue, and will likely be a welcome addition to the repertoire of organists and brass quintet groups.

This transcription assumes the use of an organ of sufficient power and brilliance to balance the volume of the brass and percussion, although it can be managed quite easily on a two-manual and pedal organ.

The transcription may be played with either one or two percussionists. A separate part is supplied for each of these options. The option for having one player includes parts for Timpani, Snare Drum and Triangle. The two player option increases the use of the Snare Drum and Triangle and adds Tambourine to the mix. The option for using two players requires two percussion parts, which are included in the purchase price.

Parts for First Trumpet are provided in B $\flat$ , C, and E $\flat$  versions. Parts for Second Trumpet are available in both B $\flat$  and C versions. These are also included in the purchase price.

My indebtedness to players who have given this transcription its initial performances, and their insightful suggestions and comments. I wish particularly to thank Stephen Bulla who made some valuable observations, and John Curry who provided helpful input for the percussion parts.
