Christmas Time in the Eyes of a Child is a light-hearted secular Christmas song for children, although it could be performed by adults. There is also a solo version and a version for children's choir with piano accompaniment that can either be sung in unison or in two parts (SA).

The words are by Linda Marcus (who wrote 'River in Judea') and the music is by Gordon Thornett. Described as 'charming' and 'beautiful' by choral directors and 'brimming with the spirit of the season' by a music publisher, this song should provide a pleasing addition to any holiday concert.

Gordon Thornett has written a number of choral pieces for Christmas, published in the UK by OUP and in Norway by Norsk Musikforlag. Some other Christmas titles are obtainable from Swirly Music. His Festive Christmas Overture 'The Joy of Christmas' is published in the UK by Faber Music.
