"Introit" was commissioned for the installation of the Revd Kenneth Cranford as Pastor of St. James the Great Parish, Darlington, England, by his son, Alexander Cranford, who directed the first performance by Voces Assumptionis. The text is taken from the English translation of the Divine Liturgy of St. James. The work may be performed a cappella or with the organ accompaniment provided. It is a short and lively call to worship that also works well as a concert work.

Patrick M. O'Shea (b. 1967, Worcester, Massachusetts) serves as Professor of Music and Director of Choirs at Saint Mary's University of Minnesota. He holds the degrees from Arizona State University, the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, and Shenandoah Conservatory of Music. His composition teachers included Russell Woollen, Thomas Fredrickson and Randall Shinn. He writes predominantly choral and vocal music, but has also produced works for various chamber ensembles and piano.
