This hymn features wonderful lyrics and imagery of The Lord's presence and benevolence, and I wanted to reflect this in this re-working. Taking the hymn out of its original 3/4 time, the hymn is now in 4/4, giving it a more contemporary lilt, and featuring more modal and flowing harmony, merging what, I hope, is the traditional with the modern, re-inventing the hymn for more youthful and contemporary performers.
