Il ciclo Due pezzi di ghiaccio (1995) continua il mio interesse per il dualismo tra due movimenti contrastanti. Questo titolo insolito si riferisce a un'impressione suscitata dopo un viaggio in una regione montuosa ricca di paesaggi ghiacciati. L'idea di mettere in relazione la geometria del ghiaccio con quella musicale m'interessava.

I due pezzi (Allegro brillante – Andante) non sono solo contrastanti nel carattere, ciascuno è diviso in diverse sezioni che elaborano il materiale tematico in modi nuovi.

NOTES

The cycle Two Pieces of ice (1995) continue my interest on the dualism between two contrasting movements. This unusual title refers to an impression aroused after a trip on a mountainous region full of icy landscapes. The idea to relate the geometry of ice with that of music was interesting for me.

The two pieces (Allegro brillante – Andante) are not only contrasting in character, each piece is divided into different sections which elaborate the thematic material in new ways.
